Cabin Assignments

Campers are pre-assigned to cabins and every effort is made to fill **REQUESTED** cabin mates before arrival at camp. Cabin changes will not be made Monday morning.

Closing Ceremonies will begin each Saturday @ approx. 9:15 AM and your camper will be ready to go home by 10:30. Program will include awards, favorite camp songs, plus an exciting video collage of your child's week of camp! Family & friends are welcome...but parking is limited! Patience will be required as we cope with the abundance of cars, people and energy.

Payment/Cancellation/Refund Policies

Registration includes all meals, activities, crafts, all camp photo and team t-shirt. No refunds after your week of camp begins. Final payment is due one week before session begins. There is a \$25 cancellation fee up until two weeks before session; \$125 cancellation fee during two weeks prior to session; NO REFUND on Monday, first day of session, or later.

Health & Medications

A Health Care Professional will be on site to handle all accident or illness related problems that arise and to administer all medications, both prescription and over the counter. All prescription drugs must be in original container with dosage & instructions on the label. Turn all medications in to the nurse upon arrival. Red Cross certified lifeguards and activity instructors provide a safe environment for activities.

Dietary Needs

Nutritious meals are served & health related diets can be accommodated, if planned ahead of time. If your child has dietary restrictions that require special meals, email our cook:

Spending Money

At Camp Gilead we have our own store, Pop's Inn. We will set up an account for your child at check in. Campers have the opportunity to visit the store daily. The store is stocked full of fun camp souvenirs, water bottles, sweatshirts, as well as candy, pop and ice cream. The suggested daily amount is \$3-4 for candy per day, plus money for souvenirs! Sweatshirts range from \$20-\$40.
